Statement of Intent : Art, Craft and Design

Intent

Children will:

- Be able to express themselves visually
- Use a wide range of media and materials effectively
- Have a critical understanding and awareness of different artists, designers and craftspeople and over a range of periods and cultures
- Draw effectively for a range of purposes

Implementation

Staff will:

- Plan directly from National Curriculum (Y1-6) Expressive Arts and Design Statutory Educational Programme (N-Rec) meeting the needs of all pupils including those with SEND
- Deliver well-paced, engaging lessons that provide opportunity to develop key skills in art
- Draw upon a wide range of artists, designers and craftspeople of different gender and cultures to inspire, and to teach key skills
- Provide useful, verbal feedback to pupils to enable them to develop their art work further.

Impact

The impact of a clear and consistent approach to the teaching of Art is:

- all lessons are well planned, delivered and resourced
- staff have strong subject knowledge, a clear understanding of expectations and a consistent approach to the teaching of Art
- pupils make at least expected progress against their initial starting points in Art and are able to draw competently and confidently for a range of purposes
- pupils are well equipped for each stage of their education
