Art

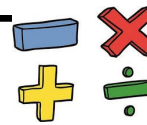
We will be looking at the work of architects from around the world and using what we find to help us design our own bridge. We will then move on to painting. We will look at how artists use paint and colours to create abstract art.

Maths



We will be learning about money . We will focus on recognising coins before using it to help us solve addition and subtraction problems. We will move onto comparing and measuring length and heights and then mass, capacity and temperature. We will continue to develop our knowledge of number bonds to 100, add 3 1-digit numbers, two 2-digit numbers (not across a 10 and across a 10) and subtract across and from a 10.

Design Technology
