We will be encouraging children to read for pleasure through exploring fiction and non fiction texts. Children will continue to access 'Learning to Read' sessions linked to half termly assessments. Children in Year 2 will sit the KS1 SATS in the month of May.

History



We will be learning about the Monarchs of Great Britain. We will learn about and compare the reigns of Queen Victoria, Queen Elizabeth the first and second as well as consider King Charles' plans for his reign.

Art



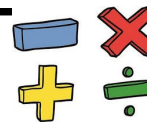
In Summer 1 we will be looking at sculpture and using natural objects to make sculptures. We will make treehouses and worry dolls. Then we will move on to our art and music topic where we look at mark making to music and collaborate to make a large scale orchestra art piece.

RE

This term we will be learning about how Buddhists worship and express their beliefs. We will also consider what we can learn from our local faith communities.



Maths



We will be focusing on numbers to 100 and partitioning these numbers into tens and ones. We will also be focusing on telling the time to the hour and half hour and then using this to solve problems. Continuing to practise our 2, 5 and 10x tables and solve problems using these facts. In fractions we will be finding halves and quarters of shapes and amounts. Year 1 will be encouraged to use positional and directional language. Finally we will be working on 3D shapes and their properties.

Design Technology

We are going to be exploring stable structures, specifically looking at toy garages. We are going to look at the efficacy of different toy garages and their materials and then design, make and evaluate our own.

PE

In P.E we will be revisiting dancing skills learned earlier in the year to develop sequences in time with friends to create our own dance moves to music. We will be continuing to learn skipping skills to skip effectively. We will develop throwing and catching skills using a range of equipment which will be used in games.



Science

In Science we will be learning about animals and that they have offspring which will grow into adults. We will consider their needs for survival. We will consider the need of correct diet, exercise and hygiene for human survival. In Summer term we will observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow. We will consider their needs to survive.



Geography

We will be doing a Caribbean Study this term to compare different environments in which we live in linking to human and physical features. We will compare climate and geographical features of maps of Newcastle to Jamaica.

Computing

In Computing, children will be learning to use presentation software and developing their typing skills in order to present their ideas. They will also be using Scratch Jr to create and code a simple game. They will learn the basics of visual coding and new concepts such as conditional language, repeat loops and how to debug their games.

PSHE

We will be looking at building positive relationships and begin to understand that they can all be different We will continue to discuss how to resolve conflict. In Summer 2 we will discuss how to cope positively with change.

Music

We will be continuing to sing, rap, rhyme, chant and use spoken word. Demonstrate good singing posture. Sing songs from memory. Copy back intervals of an octave and fifth (high, low). Sing in unison. We will be developing performance skills, adding actions and improvisation skills to perfect our performance.
