

Tickets

Tickets for the Xmas performances will be available next week from the main office.

Ticket collection times will be from 9.00am

(Please stand clear of the doors to allow late arrivals to enter school safely) and after 3.00pm all of next week.

The office staff will do their very best to manage the volume of ticket collections efficiently whilst also carrying out their other duties, so we do ask for patience at busy times.

Each Key Stage team will have 2 performances. There will be a maximum of 4 tickets per family and not per performance. Please only take tickets that you require.

We do not charge for tickets but there will be a donations bucket at the end of each performance, alternatively you can make a donation via School Gateway.

Xmas Events

We are delighted that the Friends of Westmoor have agreed to organise the Xmas film and disco events. In the interest of safeguarding we politely ask you to read and then follow the guidance below:

- There will be a school staff presence for safeguarding and first aid purposes.
- Children should be dropped off by a parent or carer at the main office door and attendance will be registered against our list of ticket sales.
- Parents and carers are not required to stay unless they are part of the 'Friends' group of helpers.
- Children may bring a small amount of money to spend on tuck. This is optional. Items available will be nut free.
- Children will not be permitted to have mobile phones during these events. As parents and carers will be at drop off and pick up there should be no need to carry a phone.
- Children will be allocated a place to hang coats within school.
- Due to the volume of children leaving each of the events, we will allocate a school staff member to each of the hall fire exit doors to ensure this is managed safely. Parents and carers please collect from the following exits.
