<u>English</u>

We will be encouraging children to read for pleasure through exploring fiction and non fiction texts. Children will be developing their inference and comprehension skills using a range of texts. Children will continue to access 'Learning to Read' sessions linked to half termly assessment. Through a range of texts we will continue to develop writing stamina when writing fiction and non fiction. We will be focusing on using the correct tense to write cohesive pieces of work. We will continue to correctly use punctuation and learn how to use apostrophes for possession as well as using the suffixes –ness, less, -ment.

History

We will be learning about and comparing the lives of Rosa Parks and Emily Davison. We will consider their national and international achievements during the time periods they lived in. We will compare this to how this has an impact today.

<u>Art</u>

Our Art topic this term is sculpture! We will consider what sculpture is before we explore materials we can use to create this type of artwork. We will collect ideas and information from others to create our own sculptures.

<u>RE</u>

We will be learning what it means to belong to the Christian faith and how Christians celebrate Easter.



<u>Maths</u>

We will be learning about money . **We** will focus on recognising coins before using

it to help us solve addition and subtraction problems. We will be continuing to develop our 2x, 5x and 10x table and using our multiplication facts to divide. We will move onto comparing and measuring length and heights and then mass, capacity and temperature. We will continue to develop our knowledge of number bonds to 100, add 3 1-digit numbers, two 2-digit numbers (not across a 10 and across a 10) and subtract across and from a 10

Design Technology
