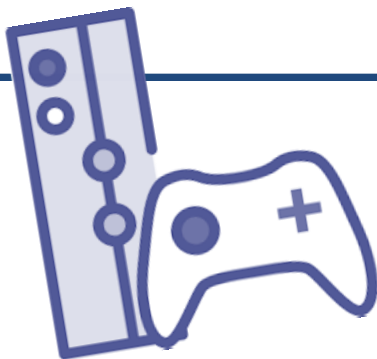
Technology is forever advancing and it can be hard trying to protect your device from harm.

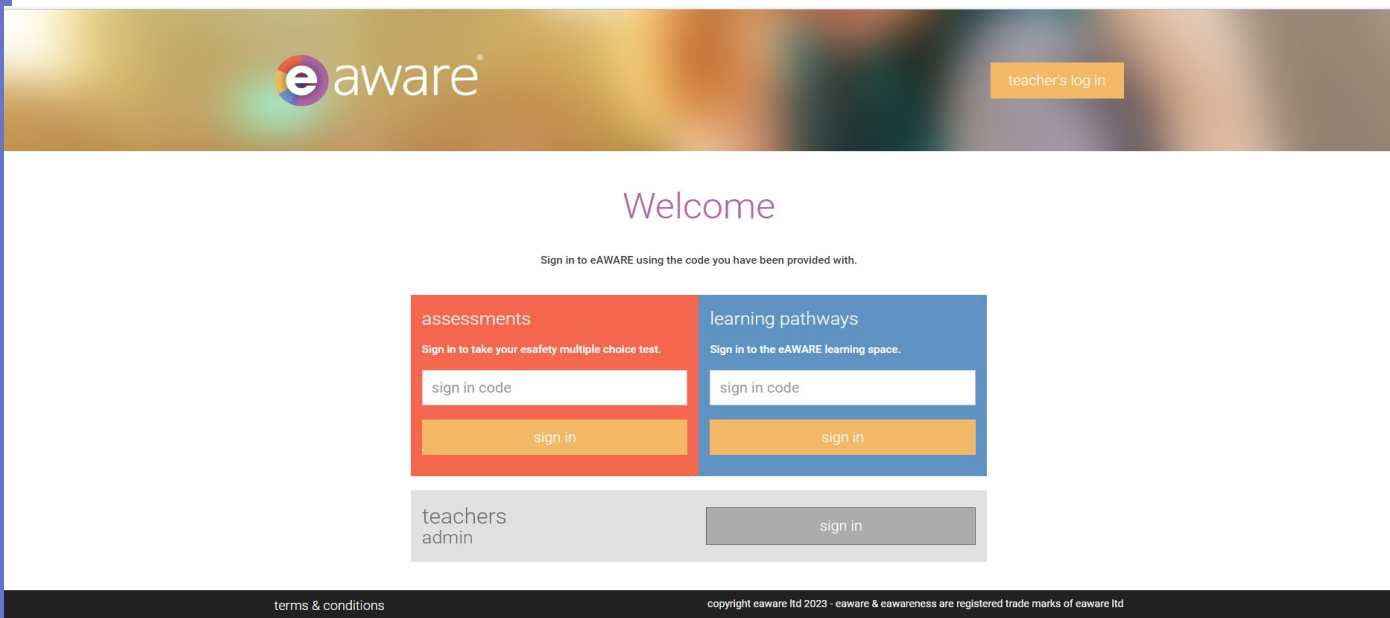
E-SAFETY SURVEY
