

English



Through a range of texts we will focus on correct spelling of common exception and applying these skills in our writing. We will develop stamina in writing and start to include the correct use of tenses. We will be exploring the use of commas in a list as well as adding conjunctions. We will work on reading and editing our own work to make changes or add in missing words. We will be looking at Wishing tales, Cumulative tales, information texts and diary entries. In reading we will develop comprehension and inference skills to answer questions about a text which will increase in size. We will use exciting vocabulary choices from our reading to include in our writing.

Computing

In Computing, we will be looking at how to use technology safely and appropriately and how to be safe online. We will also be looking at using technology to collate and present data when looking at Minibeasts.



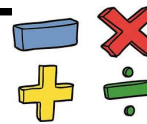
PSHE

We will be learning about the importance of family and how not all families are the same. We will also be looking at the importance of friendships and how to solve and resolve arguments and ask for help. We will then discuss some online safety with regards to staying safe and seeking help. We will also discuss bullying with regard to respecting others.

RE

In Autumn 1 we will be learning about how special the Bible is to Christians and some of the stories within the Bible. In Autumn 2, we will look at Diwali and the festival of lights and link that back to Christianity and why light is important at Christmas.

Maths



We will be learning about the value of two digit numbers and how we can partition the numbers into smaller parts using different models and equipment. We will be adding and subtracting within 100 using practical resources and then more abstract methods. We will be recapping our 2 and 10 times table and building up our 5 and 3 times tables using this to solve problems. We will name and consider the properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

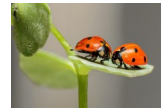

Design Technology

We will be creating designs for our moving Minibeasts. We will be using a range of tools and equipment. We will be cutting, shaping, joining and finishing.



PE

In P.E we will be focussing on gymnastics and movement through control of the body. We will be looking at putting together some sequences of movement.

We will also be looking at ball skills including stopping and retrieving the ball as well as using aiming at a target and hitting the ball.

Science

In Science we will be naming and identifying common animals as well as classifying them into carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. We will be describing and comparing the structure of animals and how they are suited to their habits. We will also be observing changes across the four seasons and observing and describing the weather linked to them. This will include how day length varies.

Geography



We will be looking at a "Bird's eye view" of Killingworth and creating understanding the difference between aerial and ground views. We will be using compass points to direct ourselves around the local area and then creating a junk model version of our area which we can direct Beebots around.

History

We will be looking at "Our local area from our local heroes." We will be listening to local people speak about our local Westmoor area through the years and finding out how much it has changed from when there were dinosaurs in Killingworth! We will also be visiting Stephenson Museum to learn about George Stephenson and his impact on the railways.

Art

In Autumn 1 we will be exploring creating drawings using our whole body. In Autumn 2 we will be exploring the world through mono print.



Music

We will be looking to sing, rap, rhyme, chant and use spoken word. Demonstrate good singing posture. Sing songs from memory and sing in unison. We will be developing performance skills, adding actions and improvisation skills to perfect our performance.
