

## MFL Progressive Curriculum Nursery to Year 6



Skills	Foundation Stage and Key Stage 1	Lower Key stage 2	Upper Key stage 2
Speaking	Foundation Stage and Key Stage 1 are not taught French.  However, they do take part in whole school MFL Enrichment Days, as an introduction to learning languages. Activities include:	<ul> <li>Build up a bank of vocabulary through recalling an increased quantity of nouns.</li> <li>Use the appropriate definite, indefinite and/or partitive articles.</li> <li>Use short spoken sentences with mostly accurate pronunciation.</li> <li>Include verbs, adjectives and conjunctions in their spoken sentences.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Build up a larger bank of spoken vocabulary including key phrases.</li> <li>Recall language with ease and accuracy, recalling chunks of language rather than simply just nouns with their appropriate articles.</li> <li>Speak with improved fluency and ease using full sentences (from memory) on a wider variety of topics.</li> <li>Recall key verbs, adjectives and conjunction and use them accurately.</li> <li>Speak confidently in the first person singular and begin to speak in the third person singular.</li> </ul>
Listening	<ul> <li>Learning about other cultures.</li> <li>Answering the register in different languages, e.g. bonjour, hola.</li> <li>Learning to recite numbers from 1-10.</li> <li>Learning colours.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Speak in the first person singular</li> <li>Understand short passages of spoken language, based on language taught, but also including new vocabulary.</li> <li>Appreciate familiar stories and songs in French.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Understand longer, more complex passages of spoken text including a greater amount of new vocabulary.</li> <li>Listen to spoken French at greater speed through the progressive units.</li> </ul>

Reading	*Answer the register in different languages, e.g. bonjour, hola. *Learn to recite numbers from 1-10. *Learn colours.	<ul> <li>Read short passages of text.</li> <li>Decode passages of text they are presented with by find the language they are familiar with.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Read longer passages of text with greater understanding.</li> <li>Become confident in their ability to decode passages of text, applying their knowledge to language they are less familiar with.</li> </ul>
Writing		<ul> <li>Write simple sentences which include the correct use of nouns, articles and verbs.</li> <li>Ensure grammatical accuracy and awareness in their written work, such as the spelling changes required based on the gender and plurality of nouns.</li> <li>Translate short sentences from French into English and from English to French.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Write longer passages of French text including nouns, articles, verbs, adjectives, opinions and justifications.</li> <li>Use sound grammatical knowledge to select the correct gender and plurality of nouns, the use and spelling of the different articles, regular and irregular verbs.</li> <li>Translate longer sentences from French to English and English to French with good accuracy.</li> </ul>
