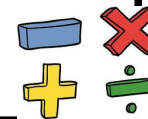


## Maths

## History - Invasion and Conflict

This term we will be studying the effects of invasion and conflict and how it has impacted and changed through British history. We will be looking at a variety of periods from the Anglo-Saxon era to 20th century conflicts.

Children be looking at a range of primary and secondary sources, and continuing to develop chronological understanding.

The children will build their flexibility, strength, technique and balance through dance and perform using a range of movements.



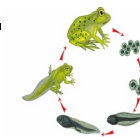
## Science
